Commissioner Covo made mention of the possible process for expansion of the BID District boundaries and wondered if that would add more members to the BID Board. Xavier Alban explained the requirements/ steps needed to begin that process. Michael Comras asked if we have explored all the possible new areas. Olaf Kohrsmeyer stated he would think this would be best during our recertification. Cynthia Seymour to help set expectations; the BID is still 5 years away from recertification and prior to making a decision as a Board, it is important to conduct an impact study to determine if the amount of additional assessment revenues is greater than the impact of maintaining and providing additional services to the additional space added. Furthermore, Xavier Alban indicated that the process is extensive and would take 7-9 months to complete the process prior to moving forward to the City Commission. Xavier Alban recommended that these types of changes might best be considered during the recertification process. The last BID renewal was completed on July 12, 2018 and the ten year anniversary would be July 12, 2028.

Let's move on to Spring Cleaning! Over the course of March-May 2023, our Operations Team has been heavily involved in the process of Spring Cleaning: Power washing the Artificial Turf on the Fitness platform in Peacock Park, Power Washing the 23 Garbage Receptacles. Power washing and Repainting the Fire hydrants, and the Curbs on Fuller.

For Arbor Day, we worked with District 2 to replace a tree on Main Highway. So Currently, all of the tree wells in Coconut Grove BID are alive and thriving.

Next Up, we are working with a local business Pietra Casa, on updating the furnishings On Fuller Street, these hand carved from coral stone and will be installed in the next 8-10 Weeks. Prior to that, we are working with City of Miami Public Works to do a Milling and resurfacing on the roadway. So Fuller will have a new and refreshed "look" by the Beginning of the upcoming tourism season starting in October.
